BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2305.401 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:

(5) "Person" has the same meaning as in section 1.59 of the	21

(B)(1) Except as provided in divisions (B)(2) and (3) of this	27
