BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1.	That	section	2947.23	of	the	Revised	Code	be	5
amended to read	as f	follows:							б

Sec. 2947.23. (A) In all criminal cases, including violations of ordinances, the judge or magistrate shall include in the sentence the costs of prosecution and render a judgment against the defendant for such costs. If a jury has been sworn at the trial of a case, the fees of the jurors shall be included in the costs, which shall be paid to the public treasury from which the jurors were paid.

(B) If an offender fails to pay the judgment described in14division (A) of this section or fails to timely make payments15towards that judgment under a payment schedule approved by the16court, the court may order the offender to perform community17service in an amount of not more than forty hours per month until18the judgment is paid or until the court is satisfied that the19

offender is in compliance with the approved payment schedule.	20
Ordering an offender to perform community service under this	21
division does not lessen the amount of the judgment and does not	22
preclude the state from taking any other action to execute the	23
judgment.	24
