BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4719.21 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 4719.21. (A) As used in this section, "telephone	7
solicitation" and "telephone solicitor" have the same meanings as	8
in division (A) of section 4719.01 of the Revised Code.	9
(B) No telephone solicitor, by means of any elective blocking	10
option available to subscribers of the calling party's telephone	11
company or by any other means, shall knowingly block or authorize	12
or cause to be blocked the disclosure of the telephone number from	13
which a telephone solicitation is made.	14
(C) A violation of division (B) of this section is an unfair	15
or deceptive act or practice in violation of section 1345.02 of	16
the Revised Code. A person injured by a violation of division (B)	17
