(B) Fail to maintain a valid certificate of registration or	20

(C) Advertise that one is registered as a telephone solicitor	22
or represent that registration as a telephone solicitor	23
constitutes approval or endorsement by any government or	24
governmental office or agency;	25
(D) Provide inaccurate or incomplete information to the	26
