To amend section 2505.12 of the Revised Code to exempt  
nonmonetary administrative-related appeals from the  
requirement of a supersedeas bond.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** That section 2505.12 of the Revised Code be  
amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 2505.12.** ~~A~~ An appellant is not required to give a  
supersedeas bond ~~does not have to be given~~ in connection with ~~an~~

(A) An appeal by any of the following:

(B) An administrative-related appeal of a final order that is 19  
not for the payment of money. 20

**Section 2.** That existing section 2505.12 of the Revised Code 21
