#### (B) Any nonpublic school or employee of a nonpublic school is 16 not liable in damages in a civil action for injury, death, or loss 17 to person or property allegedly caused by an act or omission of 18 the nonpublic school or an employee of the nonpublic school in 19 connection with performance of the duties required under division 20 (A) of this section unless such act or omission was with malicious 21 purpose, in bad faith, or in a wanton or reckless manner. 22 (C) This section does not create a new cause of action or 23 substantive legal right against any person. 24
