BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

public or college library in the state designated by the state	166
library board to be a depository for state publications. In	167
designating which libraries shall be depositories, the board shall	168
select those libraries which that can best preserve such those	169
publications and which that are so located geographically as will	170

areas of the state $\dot{\tau}$.	172
(D) Send one copy to each state in exchange for like	173
publications of such that state.	174
The provisions of this section shall not apply to any	175
publication of the general assembly or to the publications	176
described in sections 149.07, 149.08, 149.09 <u>149.091</u> , and 149.17	177
of the Revised Code, except that the secretary of state shall	178
forward to the document division of the library of congress two	179
copies of all journals, seven two copies of the session laws in	180
bound form as provided for in section $\frac{149.09}{149.091}$ of the	181
Revised Code, and seven two copies of all appropriation laws in	182
separate form.	183
Section 2. That existing sections 101.531, 111.12, 149.09,	184
149.091, and 149.11 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	185
