## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3905.45 and 3905.451 of the Revised	5

(A) If an insurance policy has been issued, sold, or assigned for	8

services, the insurer shall not pay the benefits of the insurance	10

funeral contract as defined in <u>subject to</u> section 1111.19 of the	37
