## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3704.12 of the Revised Code be	5	
enacted to read as follows:	6	
Sec. 3704.12. (A) Subject to division (C) of this section, on	7	
or after July 1, 2005, no person shall sell or deliver to any	8	
distributor within this state, or import into this state for sale		
in this state, any motor vehicle fuel containing methyl tertiary	10	
butyl ether (MTBE) in quantities greater than one-half of one per	11	
cent by volume.		
(B) The attorney general, upon the request of the director of	13

relief in any court of competent jurisdiction against any person	15
violating or threatening to violate division (A) of this section.	
The court may grant temporary as well as permanent injunctive	
relief.	
(C) The prohibitions of this section shall not operate unless	19
the United States environmental protection agency grants a waiver	
allowing this state to control or prohibit the use of MTBE in	
motor vehicle fuels. The director of environmental protection	
shall apply for this waiver in a timely manner in order to obtain	
it before July 1, 2005.
