A BILL

To enact section 4507.062 of the Revised Code to 1
establish that any applicant for a driver's 2
license, permit, or identification card who is 3
required to register with the Selective Service 4
System is deemed to have given consent for the 5
Bureau of Motor Vehicles to forward the necessary 6
registration information to the Selective Service 7
System and to require the Bureau to submit the 8
applicable information to the Selective Service 9
System. 10

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4507.062 of the Revised Code be 11
enacted to read as follows: 12

Sec. 4507.062. (A) As used in this section, "license" 13
includes a driver's license, commercial driver's license, 14
temporary instruction permit, or identification card. 15

(B) Any person who is required to register with the selective 16
service system in accordance with the "Military Selective Service 17

Act of 1967," 81 Stat. 100, 50 U.S.C. App. 451 et seq., as 18
amended, upon submission of an application for issuance or renewal 19
of a license is deemed to have given consent for the bureau of 20
motor vehicles to forward to the selective service system the 21
necessary information for such registration. 22

(C) Upon receipt of an application for issuance or renewal of 23
a license from any person who is required to register with the 24
selective service system, the bureau shall forward to the 25
selective service system, in an electronic format acceptable to 26
the system, the personal information necessary for such 27
registration. However, the bureau is not required to forward the 28
personal information if the applicant indicates in writing that 29
the applicant previously has registered with the selective service 30
system. 31

(D) Every application for a license shall do all of the 32
following: 33

(1) State that submission of the application indicates the 34
applicant's consent to registration with the selective service 35
system, if so required; 36

(2) State that if an applicant so required to register is 37
under age eighteen, the bureau will register the applicant upon 38
the applicant turning age eighteen; 39

(3) Allow an applicant to indicate that the applicant 40
previously has registered with the selective service system. 41

Section 2. Section 4507.062 of the Revised Code, as enacted 42
by this act, shall take effect six months after the effective date 43
of this act. 44
