To enact section 4507.062 of the Revised Code to
establish that any applicant for a driver's
license, permit, or identification card under
twenty-six years of age who is required to register
with the Selective Service System is deemed to have
given consent for the Bureau of Motor Vehicles to
forward the necessary registration information to
the Selective Service System and to require the
Bureau to submit the applicable information to the
Selective Service System.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4507.062 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 4507.062. (A) As used in this section, "license"
includes a driver's license, commercial driver's license,

temporary instruction permit, or identification card.

(B) Any person under twenty-six years of age who is required
to register with the selective service system in accordance with
the "Military Selective Service Act of 1967," 81 Stat. 100, 50
U.S.C. App. 451 et seq., as amended, upon submission of an
application for issuance or renewal of a license is deemed to have
given consent for the bureau of motor vehicles to forward to the
selective service system the necessary information for such
registration.

(C) Upon receipt of an application for issuance or renewal of
a license from any person under twenty-six years of age who is
required to register with the selective service system, the bureau
shall forward to the selective service system in an electronic
format the personal information necessary for such registration.

(D) Every application for a license shall state that
submission of the application will serve as the applicant's
consent to registration with the selective service system, if so
required by federal law.

(E) The bureau may accept money from the selective service
system to pay any costs that the bureau incurs in implementing
this section.

by this act, shall take effect six months after the effective date
of this act.
