BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5533.68 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 5533.68. Notwithstanding any action taken by the
director of transportation pursuant to section 5511.09 of the
Revised Code to the contrary, that portion of interstate route two
hundred seventy running in a northerly and southerly direction
within western Franklin county, between the intersection of that
highway and interstate route seventy and the georgesville road
