A BILL

To amend section 101.82 of the Revised Code to exempt the Industrial Commission from the list of agencies reviewed by the Sunset Review Committee and to make appropriations for the Industrial Commission for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 101.82 of the Revised Code be amended to read as follows:

sec. 101.82. As used in sections 101.82 to 101.87 of the Revised Code:

(A) "Agency" means any board, commission, committee, or
council, or any other similar state public body required to be
established pursuant to state statutes for the exercise of any
function of state government and to which members are appointed or
elected. "Agency" does not include:

(1) The general assembly, or any commission, committee, orother body composed entirely of members thereof;17

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(2) Any court;	18

(4) The board of trustees of any institution of higher	21

(C) "Terminate" means to amend or repeal the statutes
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creating and empowering an agency, remove its personnel, and
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reassign its functions and records to another agency or officer
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designated by the general assembly.
(D) "Transfer" means to amend the statutes creating and
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empowering an agency so that its functions, records, and personnel
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(E) "Renew" means to continue an agency, and may include amendment of the statutes creating and empowering the agency, or recommendations for changes in agency operation or personnel.

Section 2. That existing section 101.82 of the Revised Code is hereby repealed.

Section 3. All items in this section are appropriated out of 59 any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the designated 60 fund. For all appropriations made in this section, those in the 61 first column are for fiscal year 2002, and those in the second 62 column are for fiscal year 2003. 63

Section 4. LAW GENERALLY APPLICABLE TO APPROPRIATIONS	86
Law contained in the main operating appropriations act of the	87

Section 5. The uncodified sections of law contained in this	91
act, and the items of law of which the uncodified sections of law	92
contained in this act are composed, are not subject to the	93
referendum. Therefore, under Ohio Constitution, Article II,	94

Section 1d and section 1.471 of the Revised Code, the uncodified 95 sections of law contained in this act, and the items of law of 96 which the uncodified sections of law contained in this act are 97 composed, go into immediate effect when this act becomes law. 98

Section 6. An item that composes the whole or part of an99uncodified section contained in this act has no effect after June10030, 2003, unless its context clearly indicates otherwise.101

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Section 7. If any item of law that constitutes the whole or 102 part of an uncodified section of law contained in this act, or if 103 any application of any item of law that constitutes the whole or 104 part of an uncodified section of law contained in this act, is 105 held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other items of law or 106 applications of items of law that can be given effect without the 107 invalid item of law or application. To this end, the items of law 108 of which the uncodified sections of law contained in this act are 109 composed, and their applications, are independent and severable. 110

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
