To enact section 5533.34 of the Revised Code to	1
designate a portion of state route number seven	2
within Columbiana County as the "Melvin E. Newlin	3
Memorial Highway."	4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5533.34 of the Revised Code be	5
enacted to read as follows:	6

<u>Sec. 5533.34. That portion of the road known as state route</u>	7
<u>number seven, commencing at the boundary of Columbiana and</u>	8
<u>Jefferson counties and extending in a northeasterly direction</u>	9
<u>through the municipal corporation of Wellsville to the</u>	10
<u>western-most boundary of the municipal corporation of East</u>	11
<u>Liverpool, shall be known as the "Melvin E. Newlin Memorial</u>	12
<u>Highway."</u>	13

<u>The director of transportation may erect suitable markers</u>	14
<u>along the highway indicating its name.</u>	15
