## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5533.34 of the Revised Code be	7

Sec. 5533.34. That portion of the road known as United States	9
route number sixty-eight running in a north and south direction,	10
commencing at the intersection of United States route number	11
sixty-eight and interstate number seventy in Clark county and	12
extending northward to the boundary of Clark county and Champaign	13
county, shall be known as the "Governor James A. Rhodes Memorial	
Highway."	15
