BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 1713.55, 3332.25, 3345.85, and	7
3701.133 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 1713.55. (A) As used in this section:	9

"institution" means a nonprofit college, university, or other	11
