A BILL

To amend sections 2305.09 and 2305.19 of the Revised 1 Code and to amend Section 3 of Am. Sub. H.B. 51 of the 125th General Assembly to modify the period 3 within which a plaintiff may commence a new action 4 after the reversal of a judgment for the plaintiff 5 or the plaintiff's failure otherwise than upon the 6 merits, to include within the four-year statute of 7 limitations for certain actions an action for 8 relief on the grounds of a physical or regulatory taking of real property, and to declare an emergency.
