Section 1. That section 3705.08 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 3705.08. (A) The director of health, by rule, shall	6
prescribe the form of records and certificates required by this	7
chapter. Records and certificates shall include the items and	8
information prescribed by the director, including the items	9
recommended by the national center for health statistics of the	10
United States department of health and human services, subject to	11
approval of and modification by the director, and all.	12
(B) All birth certificates shall include a statement setting	13
forth the names of the child's parents and a line for the mother's	14
and the father's signature.	15
