(A) Upon the creation of a park district, the 7 probate judge shall appoint three commissioners who shall take 8 office immediately and whose terms shall expire one, two, and 9 three years, respectively, from the first day of January next 10 after the date of their appointment, and thereafter. Thereafter, 11 their successors shall be appointed by such the probate judge for 12 terms of three years. Before entering upon the performance of his 13 the duties of the office, each commissioner shall take an oath to 14
