## A BILL

To amend section 4729.51 of the Revised Code to allow
the sale of oxygen to an individual who holds a
valid certificate from a nationally recognized
S.C.U.B.A. diving school.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

| Section 1. That section 4729.51 of the Revised Code be           | 5  |
