That section 5904.01 of the Revised Code be 5 enacted to read as follows: 6 Sec. 5904.01. (A) There is hereby created the Ohio veterans 7 hall of fame. The governor's office of veterans affairs shall 8 serve as the veterans hall of fame's administrative agent. The 9 veterans hall of fame shall recognize the post-military 10 achievements of outstanding veterans and spotlight all veterans! 11 contributions to the civilian workplace. 12 (B) The Ohio veterans hall of fame shall have an executive 13

committee composed of thirteen members, all of whom shall be

shall meet annually to select inductees for the veterans hall of	47
