Sec. 4715.39. (A) The state dental board may define the	6

board, licensed dentists may assign to dental assistants and other	63
qualified personnel dental procedures that do not require the	64

hygienist as this section or the board by rule authorizes dental	66
assistants and other qualified personnel to perform. The	67
performance of dental procedures by dental assistants and other	68
qualified personnel shall be under direct supervision and full	69

capacity of qualified personnel shall perform any dental procedure	94
other than in accordance with this section and any applicable	95
board rule or any dental procedure that the assistant or other	96
individual is not authorized by this section or by board rule to	97
