Section 1. That section 4715.39 of the Revised Code be	4

defined, the duties shall be defined in rules adopted in	9

include training and practice standards for dental assistants and	11
other qualified personnel. The standards may include examination	12
and issuance of a certificate. If the board issues a certificate,	13
the recipient shall display the certificate in a conspicuous	14
