(B) The prohibition against the use of any intoxicating 14 liquor contained in division (A) of this section does not apply to 15 establishments that are holders of a D-1, D-2, D-3, D-4, or D-5 16 permit whose principal business consists of conducting a hotel, a 17 restaurant, a club, or a night club<u>, all</u> as defined by in section 18
