That section 3313.13 of the Revised Code be 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 3313.13. Except as otherwise provided in this section, 7 no prosecuting attorney, city director of law, or other official 8 acting in a similar capacity shall be a member of a board of 9 education. 10 An assistant prosecuting attorney may serve as a member of a 11 board of education of a school district in any county other than 12 the county in which the assistant prosecuting attorney is employed 13 if the board of education's school district is not contiguous to 14 the county in which the assistant prosecuting attorney is 15 employed. 16
