(2) In addition to the respective designations in sections135533.30, 5533.32, and 5533.33 of the Revised Code, the road known14as interstate route seventy, extending across Ohio from the West15Virginia border in Belmont county to the Indiana border in Preble16county, and the road known as interstate route seventy-one,17extending across Ohio from the Kentucky border in Hamilton county18
