A BILL

To amend section 2151.99 of the Revised Code to 1 increase the penalty for a failure to make a mandatory report of abuse or neglect of a child 3 from a misdemeanor of the fourth degree to a 4 misdemeanor of the first degree if the child who 5 is the subject of the report that is not made 6 suffers or faces the threat of suffering the wound, injury, disability, or condition that would 8 be the basis of the report when the child is under either the direct care or supervision of the 10 offender acting in the offender's official or 11 professional capacity or the direct care or 12 supervision of another person over whom the 13 offender has supervisory control. 14
