## A BILL

To amend section 3318.31 of the Revised Code to enact

from the collective bargaining law.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

(B) The commission shall appoint and fix the compensation of	29
