## A BILL

To amend sections 4707.01 and 4707.02 of the Revised

Code to exclude persons who sell real or personal

property by means of the Internet from having to

obtain a license under the Auctioneers Law, to

revise the definition of "auction mediation

company," and to declare an emergency.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

<b>Section 1.</b> That sections 4707.01 and 4707.02 of the Revised	7

measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	131
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	132
clarify that the amendment of Chapter 4707. of the Revised Code by	133
Sub. S.B. 209 of the 125th General Assembly, which is to take	134
effect on May 6, 2005, was not intended to regulate a person who	135
