BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.2235 of the Revised Code be enacted	3

Sec. 5.2235. The month of May is designated as "Nurses Month"	5							
in recognition of the hard work and dedication of nurses and their	6

Section 2. In enacting section 5.2235 of the Revised Code, it 9 is the intent of the General Assembly to acknowledge and celebrate 10 the nurses of this state. Although nurses practice their 11 profession in a wide variety of settings, including hospitals, 12 nursing homes, other health care facilities, physician's offices, 13 schools, and even private homes, the contributions made by the 14 nursing profession in the improvement of the health care system 15 are sometimes overlooked. Therefore, the members of the 127th 16 General Assembly feel that it is vitally important that a month be 17 formally designated as "Nurses Month" for the purpose of 18 increasing public awareness of the role nurses play in the health 19 and well-being of all Ohioans. 20
