A BILL

To create the Ohio Beekeepers Task Force.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO: Section 1. (A) There is hereby created in the Department of 2. Agriculture the Ohio Beekeepers Task Force consisting of the 3 following members: 4 (1) Two members of the House of Representatives Agriculture 5 and Natural Resources Committee appointed by the Governor, each from a different political party; 7 (2) Two members of the Senate Agriculture Committee appointed 8 by the Governor, each from a different political party; 9 (3) The Chief of the Division of Plant Industry in the 10 Department of Agriculture or the Chief's designee; 11 (4) The Director of Natural Resources or the Director's 12 designee; 13 (5) Two representatives of the Ohio State Beekeepers 14

Association appointed by the Association;
