BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4503.546 of the Revised Code be 3 enacted to read as follows: 4

Sec. 4503.546. (A) Any member of the immediate family of a 5 person who died in a combat zone while a member of any branch of 6 the armed forces of the United States may apply to the registrar 7 of motor vehicles for the registration of any passenger car, 8 noncommercial motor vehicle, motor home, or other vehicle of a 9 class approved by the registrar that the family member owns or 10 leases and for issuance of "gold star family" license plates for 11 that motor vehicle. The application for "gold star family" license 12 plates may be combined with a request for a special reserved 13
