BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 4503.548 and 4503.549 of the Revised

Code be enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 4503.548. (A) Any person who served in the armed forces	6
of the United States during the Vietnam conflict and was awarded	7
the combat infantryman badge may apply to the registrar of motor	8
vehicles for the registration of any passenger car, noncommercial	9
motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle of a class	10
approved by the registrar that the person owns or leases. The	11
application shall be accompanied by such documentary evidence in	12
support of the award as the registrar may require. The application	13
may be combined with a request for a special reserved license	14
plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code.	15
Upon receipt of an application for registration of a motor	16
vehicle under this section and the required taxes and fees, and	17
upon presentation of the required supporting evidence of service	18

during the Vietnam conflict and the award of the combat	19
infantryman badge, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the	20
appropriate motor vehicle registration and a set of license plates	21
and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone when	22
required by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code.	23
In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily inscribed	24
on license plates, the license plates shall be inscribed with the	25
