<b>BE IT ENACTED</b>	BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	

### Section 1. That section 5589.99 of the Revised Code be 4 amended to read as follows: 5 Sec. 5589.99. (A) Whoever violates section 5589.01 of the Revised Code is quilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree. 7 (B) Whoever violates section 5589.02, 5589.03, 5589.05, 8 5589.06, 5589.08, 5589.081, 5589.09, 5589.11, 5589.12, 5589.32, or 9 5589.33 of the Revised Code is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. 10 (C) Whoever violates section 5589.07 or 5589.10 of the 11 Revised Code is quilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. 12 (D) Whoever violates division (A) of section 5589.21 of the 13 Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree and 14 shall be fined as follows: 15 (1) If the duration of the obstruction is longer than five 16 minutes but less than or equal to thirty minutes, one thousand 17
