BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:	
Section 1. That sections 951.02, 951.10, and 951.99 of the	4
Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 951.02. No person, who is the owner or keeper of horses,	6
mules, cattle, sheep, goats, swine, llamas, alpacas , or geese,	7
shall permit them to run at large in the public road, highway,	8
street, lane, or alley, or upon unenclosed land, or cause such the	9
animals to be herded, kept, or detained for the purpose of grazing	10
on premises other than those owned or lawfully occupied by the	11
owner or keeper of such the animals.	12
The running at large of any such animal in or upon any of the	13
places mentioned in this section is prima-facie evidence that it	14
is running at large in violation of this section.	15
Sec. 951.10. The owner or keeper of an animal described in	16
section 951.01 or 951.02 of the Revised Code, who <u>negligently</u>	17
permits it to run at large in violation of either of such those	18

sections, is liable for all damages caused by such the animal upon

Sec. 951.99. Whoever <u>recklessly</u> violates section 951.01 or	22	
951.02 of the Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor of the	23
