A BILL

To amend section 3101.08 and to enact section 101.261

of the Revised Code to permit members of the

General Assembly to perform civil marriage

ceremonies in Ohio.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3101.08 be amended and section

101.261 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	6
Sec. 101.261. Each member currently holding office in the	7
general assembly has the authority and jurisdiction to perform	8
marriage ceremonies anywhere in the state. Any fee collected by	9
the member for performance of a marriage ceremony shall be donated	10
directly to a foundation or other charitable organization that is	11
exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of	12
the Internal Revenue Code. A fee collected and donated as	13
described in this section shall not be considered a violation of	14
section 102.03 or 102.04 of the Revised Code or Section 31 of	15
Article II, Ohio Constitution.	16
