#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1.	That section	2108.31 of	the Revised	Code be	4
amended to read	as follows:				5

**sec. 2108.31.** Any person seventeen years of age or older may, 6 without consent of the person's parent or quardian, donate blood 7 in a voluntary blood program, which that is not operated for 8 profit, without consent of the person's parent or guardian. Before 9 Any person sixteen years of age but less than seventeen years of 10 age may, with consent of the person's parent or guardian, donate 11 blood in a voluntary blood program that is not operated for 12 profit. 13
