To enact section 5.2265 of the Revised Code to 1  
designate May as "ALS Awareness Month." 2

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 5.2265 of the Revised Code be enacted 3  
to read as follows: 4

**Sec. 5.2265.** The month of May is designated as "ALS Awareness 5  
Month." ALS is an acronym for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, a 6  
disease that is commonly known as Lou Gehrig's disease and that 7  
attacks the nerves and causes degeneration in muscle control and 8  
movement. 9
