Section 1. That section 3901.711 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 3901.711. (A) A department or agency of this state shall	8
not implement or enforce a provision of the federal "Patient	9
Protection and Affordable Care Act" (2010) unless both of the	10
following conditions are satisfied:	11
(1) The department or agency submits a report to the general	12
assembly containing the information described in division (B) of	13
this section.	14
(2) The Revised Code specifically authorizes the department	15
or agency to implement or enforce the provision or, if such	16
authorization does not exist, the general assembly enacts such	17
authorization.	18
