money to pay the costs of the educational activities and programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state.

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 115 contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.551 116 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other source, 117 including donations, gifts, and grants, that is designated by the 118 source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund.
