A BILL

To enact section 5.2267 of the Revised Code to 1 designate the month of September as "Craniofacial 2 Acceptance Month." 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO: Section 1. That section 5.2267 of the Revised Code be enacted 4 to read as follows: 5 Sec. 5.2267. The month of September is designated as 6 "Craniofacial Acceptance Month" to increase public awareness of 7 craniofacial conditions and advances in medical treatment of these conditions. 9 Section 2. In enacting section 5.2267 of the Revised Code, 10 the General Assembly hereby finds the following: 11 (1) Approximately one hundred thousand children are born each 12 year in the United States with a craniofacial condition affecting 13 the child's head, neck, extremities, or organs. 14 (2) Treatment of a craniofacial condition often lasts from 15 infancy to adulthood and it is not uncommon for a child to undergo 16 multiple surgeries before reaching adulthood. 17 (3) Most craniofacial conditions affect individuals and their 18
