route and state route number six hundred nineteen in Stark county	9
and extending in a northerly direction and ending at the boundary	10
of Stark and Portage counties, shall be known as the "First Lt.	11
Ashley White Stumpf Memorial Highway."	12
The director of transportation may erect suitable markers	13

along the highway indicating its name.
