BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5533.051 be amended and sections	10
5501.313, 5533.182, 5533.183, 5533.221, 5533.542, 5533.725,	11
5533.755, 5533.831, 5533.832, 5533.921, and 5533.98 of the Revised	12
Code be enacted to read as follows:	13
Sec. 5501.313. (A) The director of transportation, in	14
consultation with the director of public safety and the	15
superintendent of the state highway patrol, may designate portions	16
of state highways that are located outside of municipal	17
corporations, with each portion not exceeding twenty miles in	18
length, as a separate memorial highway in honor of each state	19
highway patrol trooper who is or has been killed in the line of	20
duty.	21
(B) In acting under this section, the director of	22
transportation may designate a portion of a state highway that is	23
located outside of a municipal corporation that has been given a	24
designation in Chapter 5533. of the Revised Code, and if the	25
director does so that portion shall have both names. If the	26
director designates any such portion under this section and that	27
portion subsequently is given a designation in Chapter 5533. of	28
the Revised Code, that portion shall have both names unless the	29
designation in Chapter 5533. of the Revised Code expressly	30
