Sec. 5501.313. (A) The director of transportation, in 14

consultation with the director of public safety and the

superintendent of the state highway patrol, may designate portions	16	
of state highways that are located outside of municipal		
corporations, with each portion not exceeding twenty miles in		
length, as a separate memorial highway in honor of each state		
highway patrol trooper who is or has been killed in the line of		
<u>duty.</u>		
(B) In acting under this section, the director of	22	
transportation may designate a portion of a state highway that is	23	
located outside of a municipal corporation that has been given a	24	
designation in Chapter 5533. of the Revised Code, and if the	25	
director does so that portion shall have both names. If the	26	
director designates any such portion under this section and that		
portion subsequently is given a designation in Chapter 5533. of	28	
the Revised Code, that portion shall have both names unless the	29	
designation in Chapter 5533. of the Revised Code expressly		
provides otherwise.		
(C) Upon a designation made under this section, the director	32	
of transportation may erect suitable markers along the state	33
