prohibit submission of a student's personal

identifiable information to the federal government

That section 3301.97 of the Revised Code be 6 enacted to read as follows: 7 Sec. 3301.97. (A) No public school shall be required by any 8 state law, any rule of the state board of education, or other 9 regulation or guideline of the department of education to submit 10 personally identifiable information of a student to any office, 11 agency, or department of the federal government. 12 (B) To the extent that it complies with the federal "Family 13 Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, 88 Stat. 571, 20 14 U.S.C. 1232q, as amended, no public school, without consent, shall 15 submit personally identifiable information of a student, including 16

any information that may be required to receive a grant pursuant
