BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 2923.221 and 3701.051 of the Revised 12 Code be enacted to read as follows: 13

Sec. 2923.221. (A) A person who sells a firearm in this state14on or after the date that is six months after the effective date15of this amendment shall provide the purchaser with the following16information:17

(1) A printed copy of the study posted on the department of18health's web site pursuant to section 3701.051 of the Revised Code19that describes the types of bodily injury that can be incurred by20the user of the firearm and by others in proximity to the firearm21

following the discharge of the firearm;	22
(2) A list of all of the types of ammunition that can be used	23
<u>in the firearm.</u>	
(B) Whoever violates division (A) of this section is quilty	25
<u>of failure to provide information to a purchaser of a firearm, a</u>	26
felony of the first degree.	27
Sec. 3701.051. The director of the department of health shall	28
conduct a study to determine and describe the types of bodily	29
injuries that can be incurred by the user of a firearm and by	30
others in proximity to a firearm following the discharge of a	31
firearm. The study shall be completed within six months of the	
effective date of this amendment and shall be posted on the	33
department's web site. The director shall update the study and	34
post an updated version every three years thereafter.	35
