BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.092 of the Revised Code be enacted	11
to read as follows:	12
Sec. 5.092. The song, "Hang on Sloopy," the words and music	13
of which were written by Wes Farrell and Bert Russell, and which	14
includes the following lyrics, is designated as the official rock	15
song of the state:	16
