BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2927.12 of the Revised Code be	7
amended to read as follows:	8
Sec. 2927.12. (A) As used in this section:	9
(1) "Disability" has the same meaning as in section 4112.01	10
of the Revised Code.	11
(2) "Gender identity" means the gender-related identity,	12
appearance, or mannerisms of an individual, or other	13
gender-related characteristics of an individual, with or without	14
regard to the individual's designated gender at birth.	15
(3) "Sexual orientation" means actual or perceived	16

heterosexuality, homosexuality, or bisexuality.	
(B) No person shall violate section 2903.21, 2903.22,	18
2909.06, or 2909.07, or division (A)(3), (4), or (5) of section	19
2917.21 of the Revised Code by reason of the race, color,	20
religion, or national origin, gender identity, sexual orientation,	
or disability of another person or group of persons.	
$\frac{B}{C}$ Whoever violates this section is guilty of ethnic	23
intimidation. Ethnic intimidation is an offense of the next higher	24
degree than the offense the commission of which is a necessary	
element of ethnic intimidation.	
Section 2. That existing section 2927.12 of the Revised Code	27
