#### ABILL

To enact section 5533.471 of the Revised Code to 1 designate a portion of State Route 264 within the 2 city of Cincinnati as the "Elder High School 3 Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway"; to authorize 4 the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name; and 6 to authorize Elder High School, subject to approval by the Director, to erect auxiliary 8 markers on a periodic basis indicating the name of 9 one of the eleven Elder High School graduates who 10 died during the Vietnam conflict. 11
