A BILL

To amend sections 3107.062, 3107.065, 3107.066, and 1 3107.99; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a 2 new section number as indicated in parentheses, 3 section 3107.066 (3107.067); and to enact new 4 section 3107.066 of the Revised Code to provide 5 that ineffective promotion of the putative father 6 registry does not relieve a putative father of the consequences of failing to timely register with 8 the putative father registry and to make false 9 registration a first degree misdemeanor. 10
